On October 13th, ten speed-hungry Polar Region members went racing at Edmonton's newest locale for automotive enthusiasts: **Impulse SimRacing**. We hopped into the ten handcrafted racing simulators to get acquainted. We adjusted our seats, grabbed the steering wheel, flicked the paddle shifters (stick shift is also available) and danced on the pedals. Then we started our engines. What were we driving? Porsche GT3 Cup Cars of course. The car was a great match for the Portugal International course in Estoril, Portugal.

The simulators at **Impulse SimRacing** offer realistic vibration feedback through the seat and steering wheel plus your field of vision is fully occupied by three large LCD monitors. To cap off the sensory overload, all drivers are wearing headphones to recreate all the noises from the cockpit. As an added bonus, the headphones are equipped with microphones allowing all the racers on the track to communicate with one another. However, the high level of concentration kept the chatter to a minimum. Generally, the only time you heard anything spoken, it was a colourful word as someone left the pavement for an impromptu trip through the gravel traps.

This isn't your kid's arcade game. These simulators offer the truest representation of race car driving available today. The software is rFactor 2 which is used by Formula 1 drivers around the world to help perfect their skills in their own cars at every circuit.

Unlike arcade games where the cars often have physically impossible levels of speed, grip and handling characteristics, rFactor 2 models real-world physics from each individual car providing drivers with an experience as close to the real thing as possible. Even tire wear is realistic. If you lock your brakes and create flat spots on the tires, you will feel the machine vibrating as you drive while the flat spots slap the pavement on every rotation. Your pit crew can swap all four tires and fill your fuel tank in about 35 seconds.

One of the luxuries of a typical race car arcade game is the map of the track that hovers on the screen to keep you aware of the type of corner that is next approaching. But since real race cars never have track maps taped to the windshield, nor do racing simulators. It is therefore critical to study and ideally memorize a track layout prior to driving it. Planning your line, breaking points and gear changes will significantly benefit your lap times.

One aspect I personally found very helpful was the opportunity to acquaint myself with left-foot braking. The technique is hugely popular with professional drivers but is more commonly thought of as a "bad habit" used only on the street by cab drivers and the elderly. If you want to learn how to left-foot brake on a track without the risk of crashing your cherished Porsche or giving yourself whiplash, this is the place to practice.

After about an hour of racing, Geoff Samuel, Tim's son, emerged with the fastest lap of the evening, nearly a second and a half ahead of the next fastest - Jim Whitelaw.

This first event was a casual drop-in style event and all in attendance would agree it was a success. We will certainly plan for more track time at **Impulse SimRacing** in the future so watch our webpage, your email inbox and the Polar Region facebook page for details.
